A sound meditation is an immersive experience inspired by the practice of Deep Listening created by the American composer and accordionist Pauline Oliveros. Participants sit in a circle with the musicians. The performance has a ritual character and begins with a "warm-up" carried out according to the principles of the Alexander Technique. It serves as a tuning of mind and body, as preparation for the act of listening: by easing mental and physical tension, balancing posture, freeing the breath, participants can achieve greater awareness and sensitivity: in a contemplative state, the sound resonates in the body and imagination of each listener in a unique way, creating a collective experience aware of the process of transformation that involves both the performer and the audience.







Technical requirements

The approximate duration of the program is 75 minutes

Specifics:

- 4 Active speakers (quad): 2 front stages and 2 back 4 XRLcables (from the stage to the speakers, ca 20 meters Power supplies available on stage
- 1 (or 2) chair
- 1 (or 3) music stands
